

Natural Latex Cherry Soothers



Care Instructions

DO NOT STORE NEAR SUNLIGHT

- **Soothers have a limited life. Always inspect carefully before and after each use, especially when the child has teeth. Pull the teat part in all directions. Throw away at the first sign of damage or weakness, and in any event after two months' use.**
- Replace regularly as Latex is a natural product and will deteriorate with age and use.
- Throw away when worn, discoloured, sticky, smelly, soft or deflated.
- Use 3 soothers in rotation.
- Replace soothers at least every 2 months, even if soother still appears to be in good condition.
- **Do not leave soother in direct sunlight when not in use or near another source of light or heat, or leave in a sterilising solution for longer than recommended, as this may weaken the latex teat.**
- Some medicines, strong washing detergents and teething gels can weaken the latex teat
- Do **not** pull soother apart or attempt to reinflate.

The aircushioned teat acts as a safety warning - if the soother deflates or appears flat, it indicates a bite hole or other damage

- Do **not** dip teat in sweet substances (e.g. jam, syrups, honey) as this can lead to tooth decay
- Do **not** attach pins, ribbons or string to any part of the soother (i.e. around the ring, plug or through the ventilation holes) as these can be strangulation hazards. Strangulation hazards include the cutting off of blood supply to fingers and limbs.
- In the event that the soother becomes lodged in the mouth, be aware it cannot be swallowed and is designed to cope with such an event. Remove from the mouth with care as gently as possible.

Sterilising

Before each use, inspect and thoroughly clean, then sterilise the soother and cover by either:

- (a) immersing entire soother in baby-bottle sterilising solution in accordance with instructions for use of the sterilising solution, **or**
- (b) boiling the soother in a saucepan with plenty of water for a maximum period of 5 minutes.
- Do **not** sterilise in microwave or dishwasher.
- Do **not** over sterilise (immerse in sterilising solution or boil for longer than recommended) as this will cause faster deterioration of the latex teat.
- When soother is not intended to be used immediately after sterilisation, shake and/or air dry, attach the protective cover and store in a cool, dark, dry, covered container until soother is required.
