Care Instructions

- To ensure hygiene, clean before each use, wash in warm soapy water to remove all deposits.
- After washing, sterilise by boiling in water (for a maximum of 5 minutes), using baby bottle sterilising solution in accordance with instructions (for one hour only) or a microwave sterilising unit.
- Do not microwave latex teats.
- Always heat in microwave with lid off and check temperature before serving.
- When dry, store in a dry covered container.
- Inspect before each use and pull the feeding teat in all directions, throw away at the first signs of damage or weakness.
- Do not leave a feeding teat in direct sunlight or heat, or leave in sterilising solution for longer than recommended, as this may weaken the teat.
- We recommend latex teats be replaced every seven weeks for safety and hygiene.
- If teat is collapsing, simply try loosening (anticlockwise) the bottle collar slightly.
- Ensure this product's longevity by avoiding rapid temperature changes, such as: Pouring boiling water into a bottle taken from the fridge, or placing the bottle under a cold running tap when it has been filled with hot liquid (especially after it has been heated in the microwave).
- Always discard any Happy Baby bottle that has been chipped, knocked or dropped.
